Basis of Assessment

Among the evidence considered will be the employer's report and confirmation from the entrant's college/training centre with regard to:

- Standard of workmanship
- Organisation of work
- Range, knowledge and understanding of best practice within the trade
- Knowledge evidence of tools, materials and surfaces
- Compliance with all Health and Safety legislation.

Judges

To maintain impartiality, judges will be drawn from Members of the Association of Painting Craft Teachers and will also include Neil Ogilvie, CEO of the PDA. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Regional events will include observations of practical work and include informal discussions with the Judges.

The Award

The winning Apprentice/Trainee and runners up will receive a trophy, a framed certificate and some fantastic prizes. These will be presented on stage at the Premier Trophy Awards to be held on Thursday 5th July 2018 at the Plaisterers' Hall, London Wall, London, EC2Y 5JU.

Entry will be by completion of this application form and the employer must endorse each application. Please note that Major Contractors are limited to a maximum of 5 entrants each.
